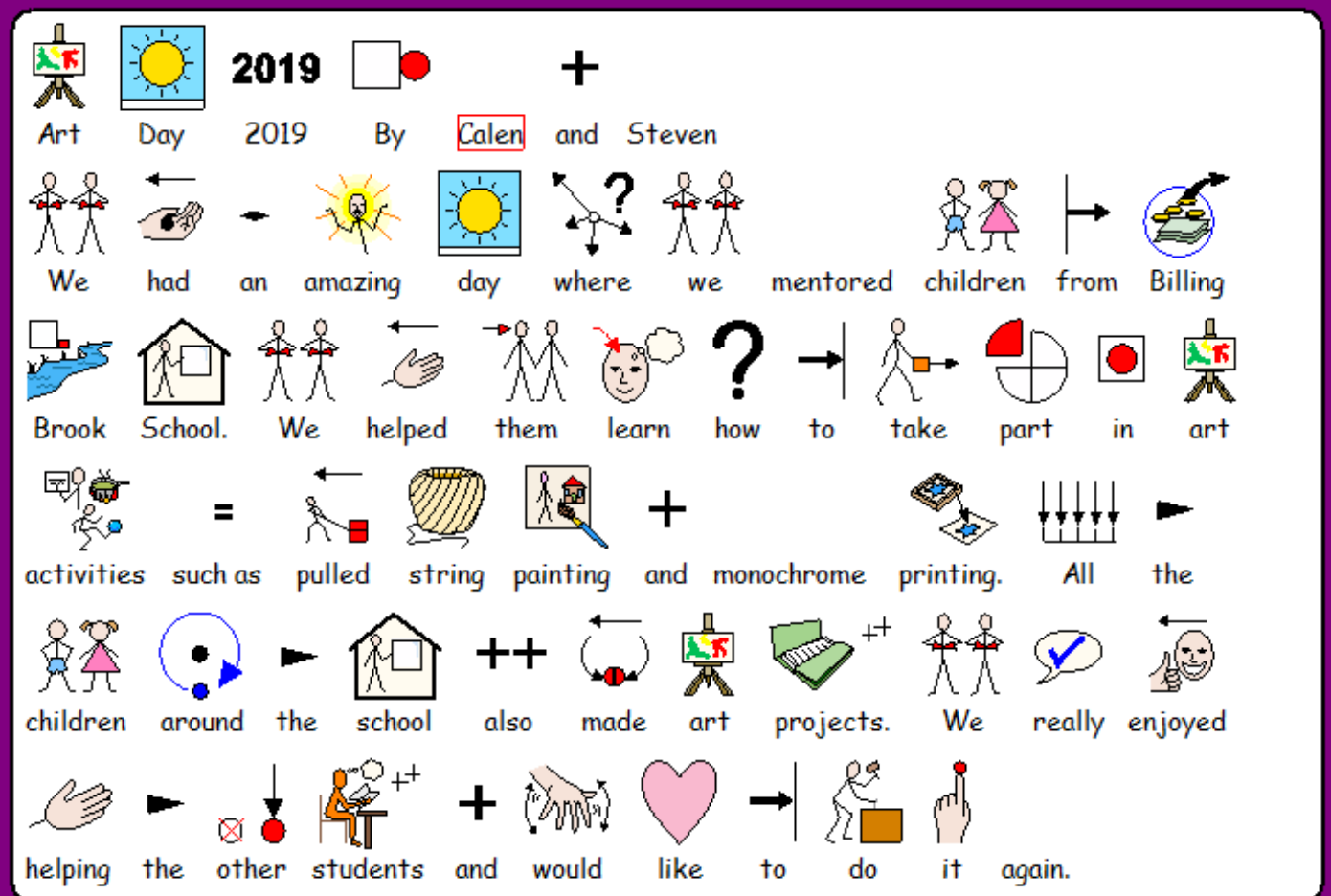

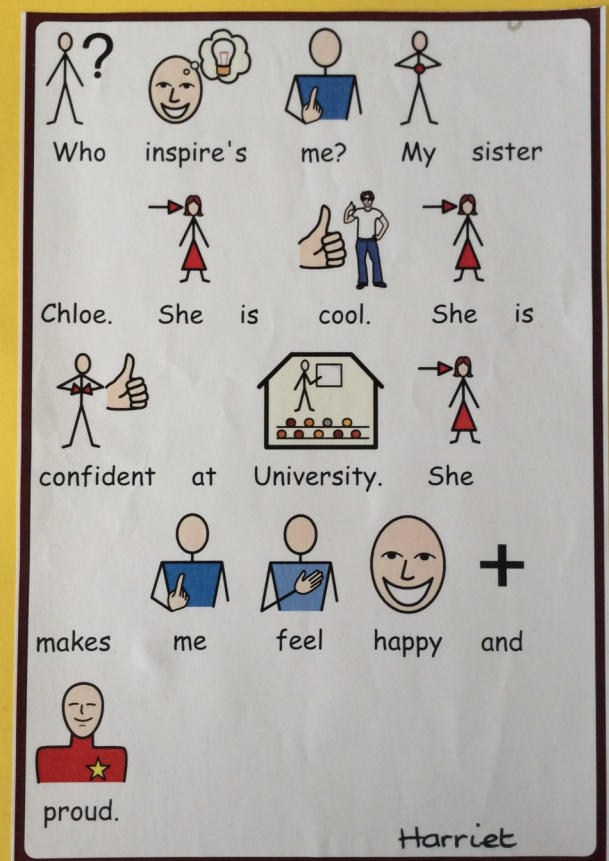

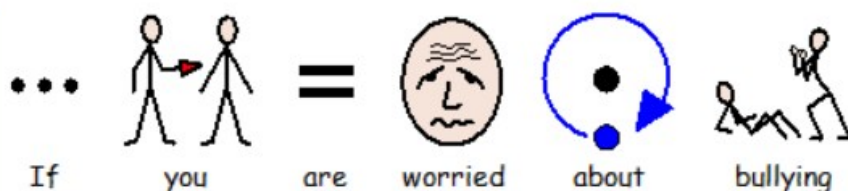


Friend of Greenfields are always looking for new volunteers and committee members.

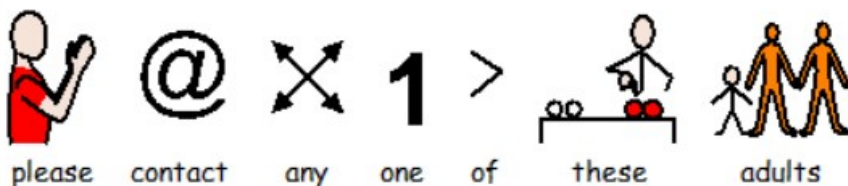
